## **Real Faces Campaign**

The Real People Campaign is real members who are well known and respected in the community agreeing to be a spokesperson and having their name plastered on benches, recycle bins, bill boards, website, and signs, etc. We do not use the business name so as to not appear as though we are promoting one business over another.

I have attached some of the images we use. Some of them with longer verbiage are used on stand up banners while the shorter versions are used on bins and benches. We have used some as stills at the end of TV advertising as well. We change out the faces about every three years. This program has worked very well for us.

We also have another set of Real People who do some radio ads for us.

There is no charge to the participant, full cost to the Chamber as part of our marketing budget. In order to ensure there is perceived fairness in the selection process, we do a call out for interested participants. We usually have an idea who we want, but need to make it fair for everyone and last time we had one we hadn't thought of and someone who values the Chamber, really wanted to help out, and were an excellent fit so I guess we don't always know best!!
